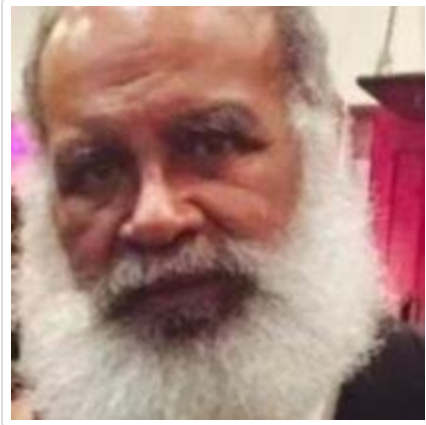




Carl Johnson
