Christine C. Moore, 76, of Chattanooga, passed away Thursday, May 30, 2024, in a local hospital. She was born in Lexington, Georgia on November 13, 1947, and was a 1966 graduate from Riverside High School. She later went back to school to receive her A.S. Degree in Business Administration at McKenzie College. She retired from Moccasin Bend Mental Health Institute after 42 years of service. Christine was a faithful member of Greater Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Church from 1989-2004, where she was a member of the Choir and the Willing Workers.
