Donald Stone Jr., 54, of Chattanooga, passed away Thursday, February 3, 2022, in a local hospital. He was a graduate of Flint Central School. Donald went on to attend the University of Wisconsin where he earned his Bachelor's degree in Occupational Safety. He later earned a Master's degree in Public Administration from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Donald proudly served the City of Milwaukee for more than 20 years. In 2016 he took his talents to Chattanooga where he served as the Deputy Administrator for the Department of Chattanooga Public Works. He is the first African American to hold this position. His greatest accomplishment was becoming a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. He was preceded in death by his parents, Donald Stone, Sr., and Debra Lynn Jackson-Stone; grandparents, Wilda E.
