Pamela Elaine Glenn-Carter, 68, formerly of Chattanooga, passed away Saturday, August 14, 2021, in a Long Beach, California hospital. She was born July 18, 1953 in Chattanooga, Tennessee, daughter of the late Arthur Eugene Glenn and Gloria Dean Glenn-Crosby. She attended Chattanooga Public Schools to include Howard High School, class of 1971, which she was an active participant in class activities until 2013. Pamela moved to Los Angeles, California in 1971 where she attended the Patricia Stevens Business School. She was employed by Cedar Sinai Medical Center and Slate and Leoni Law Firm. Pamela was a member of Saint Andrews Missionary Baptist Church, where she sang in the Cathedral Choir. She also was a member of the Occidental Inspirational Voices under the direction of Shedrick G. Wise, Jr. Pamela became a licensed cosmetologist in 1989. She was a co-owner of the Khadim of African fashions in Inglewood, California.
