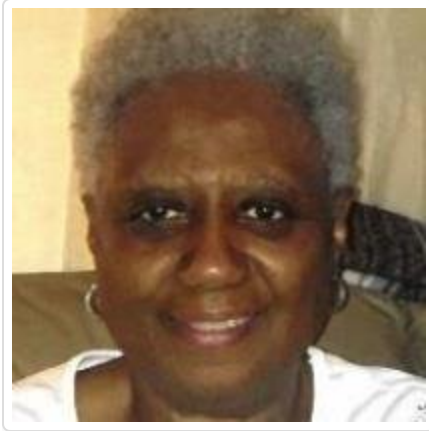




## Ms. Shirley Ann Parker
