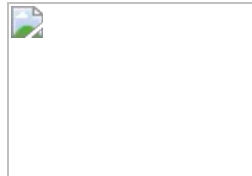
“ Tyrone and I did not share many conversations. But we always greeted one another kindly in passing. His character, and demeanor spoke volumes.

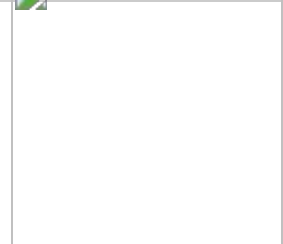
