Wilbon “Bobby” Eugene Glover, 85, of Chattanooga, passed away, June 9, 2025, in a local healthcare facility. He was born on September 22, 1939, to Sandra Young Thomas. He was raised in Moultrie, Georgia by his great-grandparents, Mattie and Sherwin Jones. There, he received his early childhood education in Colquitt County School System.

He moved to Douglasville, Georgia, where he became a member of New Mountain Top Baptist Church, where he was a part of the Missions Team and other Ministries. There, he met many new friends who became just like family. He loved hanging out with the ManCave, especially after Sunday service. They hung out and ate at different restaurants.

As his health started to take a turn, his great-nephew, Jeremiah, was there to assist and care for him in the absence of his daughter.
